

Windrock aka. Coal Creek OHV Area is 72,000 acres of off road fun, located in Oliver Springs, Tennessee. Address: 981 Windrock Road, Oliver Springs, TN 37840. Hundreds of off-roaders can be found every weekend enjoying our trails. The trails are open to everyone and just about any type of vehicle. ATV's, motorcycles, Jeeps, buggies trucks all enjoy some of the best off-roading in the country each weekend. To enter the OHV area all that is required is a simple permit that can be purchased at the trail head when you arrive. The Permit costs are: \$17 for 1 Day, \$33 for 2 Days, \$44 for 3 Days, \$55 for 4 Days, and \$88 for a Year. There are trail maps for purchase at the trailhead and the trails are all clearly marked. There is approximately 150+ miles of marked trails.

As far as lodging goes, if you are wanting to stay in a hotel the closest place is Oak Ridge, TN, which is located about 7 miles from the trailhead. The hotels are as follows:

Windrock Bed and Breakfast is located approximately 3 miles from the trail head by asphalt and also has direct access to the trail system via trail 18 or 28 so you don't have to trailer your ATV's to the trails.

On May 23-26 Coal Creek OHV Area will be having a Memorial Weekend Event. Events will include: Guided Tours, Poker Runs, Mud Bog, Sled Pulls, Drag Racing.

Also, at the trailhead is the Snack Shack that starts serving breakfast @ 7 AM everyday and they serve lunch and dinner as well. Their number is (865) 435-6971 or (865) 591-4895.

Safety Equipment is recommended but not required. There is some rougher terrain here and helmets are very much recommended. If someone traveling with you is UNDER 18 they are required to wear a helmet, it is a Tennessee Law.
